Who we are

Global Justice Group (GJG), is a US not for profit NGO, which works in Israel, Mumbai, and Erbil, Iraqi Kurdistan. GJG was created to empower victims of human rights violations, genocide and terrorism, by exposing those entities and individuals who enable the perpetrators to carry out such crimes. GJG's goal is to ensure that those who financially and logistically make it possible for these human rights violators to carry out their crimes are held accountable in courts of law for their actions. In this way, GJG seeks to create both an avenue for victims to reclaim their dignity and achieve the justice they deserve and at the same time stop these crimes from being repeated. What we need
